*Day 1:*

*Murcar*

Established in 1909 along the rugged Aberdeenshire coast, Murcar Links Golf Club stands as a monument to traditional Scottish links golf. Originally designed by Archie Simpson and later refined by the legendary James Braid in the 1930s, Murcar has spent well over a century testing the mettle of golfers from around the world. Over the years, its championship pedigree has been cemented by hosting prestigious events like the European Tour's Paul Lawrie Matchplay and the Scottish Amateur Stroke Play Championship.



Murcar is an unforgettable place to play is its raw, uncompromising layout. Carved directly into massive, rolling sand dunes, the course forces you to embrace the elements. You will face blind tee shots, steep burns (natural streams), heavily revetted bunkers, and severe humps and hollows that demand creative shot-making. When the North Sea wind starts whipping across the fairways, the course transforms into a thrilling, chess-like tactical puzzle.

Despite playing right alongside its famous neighbour, Royal Aberdeen, Murcar holds its own with immense character and arguably more dramatic elevation changes. The stretch of holes from the 2nd to the 10th takes you on an exhilarating ride through deep dune valleys with sweeping panoramic views of the sea.

Combined with a warm, authentic clubhouse atmosphere that embodies genuine Scottish hospitality, Murcar is a must-visit. It offers a pure, unadulterated links experience that honours the game's ancient roots while delivering a spectacular modern challenge.



*Day 2:*

*Experience Greatness: The Championship Links at Trump International, Scotland*

##### *Cruden Bay*
